FINE 499 Internship 8 or 15 Credits

Part or full-time work in various aspects of arts management. Sites may include galleries, musical, theatrical or other performing organizations, arts centers, or other situations that meet the instructor's approval. Halftime equals eight semester hours credit; full-time equals 15 semester hours credit.

Prerequisites: Junior standing in visual or performing arts. May also require selected courses in business, social science, etc. as appropriate to the internship sought.
